Payment may be remitted by company check or personal check; however, NO personal checks will be accepted within 21 days of departure date. All checks are payable to: Great Events. Credit cards are subject to a 4% handling fee.

If you must cancel your reservation, your right to receive a refund is limited as set forth in the following schedule: If your notice of cancellation is received outside of 90 days from departure, you will receive a full refund minus any vendor costs and/or whatever specified on your Payment Schedule. **90-60 days prior to departure**, a full refund minus \$100/person plus any applicable vendor penalties; **59-45 days prior to departure**, full refund minus \$150/person plus vendor penalties; **44-30 days prior to departure**, full refund minus \$200/person plus vendor penalties; **within 30 days of departure**, no refund. All cancellations and trip component returns will result in a minimum of a \$50/person service charge regardless of the cancellation date. Note: Reservations are generally transferable with payment of airline change fees.

CVOA Membership - Required for 2021 and 2022. Membership covers the calendar year. Your membership must be current BEFORE you can send in a reservation. You can join now, and renew in October, at www.cvoutdoors.com/join-us .

CVOA Funds - your \$50 per person non-refundable reservation fee to CVOA will be used to cover group expenses such as bus driver gratuities, a party one night, pre-trip and post-trip parties, at the discretion of the trip leader.

Trip/Travel Insurance is recommended; you can purchase it through TravelSafe, using the link in the left column of the Great Events & Escapes website, or you can use any other travel insurance company. Purchase your insurance when you make your \$1000 payment to GE&E in September.

Travel to Boston: You are responsible for getting yourself to BOS.

At BOS: You are responsible for getting yourself to the correct gate.

Acceptable Form of ID: Maine REAL ID driver's license - (if your license does not include the star, is it not REAL ID compliant) and more:

Checked Baggage Fees on United:

- First Checked Bag is \$35, Second Checked Bag is \$45. (before pre-pay discount)
- United accepts one ski/pole bag and one boot bag as one piece of checked luggage.
- Refer to united.com for more details.
- If you do not have experience traveling with ski equipment, ask someone who does.

Transfer between Bozeman and Big Sky - This is included in the package, and it is 55 miles. If you choose to do your own air and transfer (deduct \$350), factor in your transfer cost.

Groceries - We will stop at a grocery/liquor store on the way to Big Sky, subject to change or cancellation prior to trip.

Lift Tickets: Adult 5-day included in package; 6th day add \$120.
Senior (70+) 5-day deduct \$40; Senior 6-day add \$70
For “No lift ticket”, deduct \$570 from package price.

CVOA BIG SKY RESERVATION INFORMATION

The opportunity for early reservations will be given to those members who signed up for the 2021 Big Sky trip.

New reservation forms may not be postmarked before April 12, 2021.

Reservation priority will be given in the order of postmarked mail.

Members current as of February 12 (60 days prior to April 12) have priority over new or non-renewed members.

\$50.00 per person, check made out to “CVOA”, along with the completed “CVOA Big Sky Reservation Form”, will reserve your place on the trip. Reservations will be accepted until we fill the available rooms or air seats. Mail your check and the completed CVOA reservation form to Mike Parker.

Your \$50 reservation fee to CVOA is non-refundable, unless there is not room on the trip for you, or if the trip is cancelled.

Due June 10, 2021 - \$1,000.00 check made out to “Great Events” (this is your reservation confirmation payment), along with **GE&E Payment and Cancellation Form signed and completed - a couple may both sign one form. Mail both to Mike Parker.**
